- Project Name: 2023 Armor Coat

 - C-41(247) – beginning at the south end of the Chapman Bridge on Road 21, thence east along Road 21, approx. 3.6 miles to the intersection of Road 21 and Road M, thence north along Road M, approx. 1 mile to the intersection of Road M and Road 22, thence east along Road 22, approx. 1 mile, ending at Road N.
- Project Description & Scope: Approximately 10.6 miles of armor coat and other incidental work. The selected bidder shall furnish necessary equipment, transportation, labor, materials, and incidentals required to complete the work as per the Contract Documents.
