



Sample Ballots for Primary Election Tuesday, May 14, 2024

NOTICE: Please be advised this is a "Sample Ballot" and because the law requires rotation of candidates' names, the chronological order as listed may be different in your precincts. Because some listed candidates are elected in specific districts, some names listed in the "Sample Ballot" may not appear on the ballot in your precincts. In addition, due to the passage of LB56 with the Emergency Clause, voters will also see the auto-advancement of partisan county official races in which a candidate is unopposed for their party's nomination.

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

The following are instructions on how to vote your ballot. Please follow these instructions precisely, otherwise, your ballot may not be counted.

- Verify that there are initials of an election official at the bottom of the ballot.
- Verify that there are no voting marks on the ballot.
- Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.
- TO VOTE, you must darken the oval () completely.
- To vote for a WRITE-IN candidate, write in the name on the line provided AND darken the oval completely.



- Do NOT cross out or erase. If you make a mistake, contact the County Clerk's office at 402-694-3443 for instructions.
- Place voted ballot into the manilla return envelope. Write your NE driver's license or state ID in the space provided on the envelope, or enclose a photocopy of an acceptable photo ID or Reasonable Impediment Certification (if applicable). Complete, SIGN and seal the envelope. Remember to moisten both seals to cover the voter ID and signature boxes.
- Any person physically unable to sign the envelope must make his/her "mark" and must have an individual witness. Failure to complete and sign the Return Identification Envelope will cause the ballot to be rejected.
- Do NOT place more than ONE (1) voted ballot into the return identification envelope.

- Return Ballot by:
 - Hand Delivery - deliver the ballot to the office of the County Clerk/Election Commissioner.
 - Mail - return ballot by mail by placing in postage paid return envelope.
 - Drop Box Location - 1111 13th Street Aurora, NE, 68818
- Ballot MUST be in the possession of the County Clerk's office by 8:00 p.m. Central Time/7:00 p.m. Mountain Time on May 14, 2024.
